

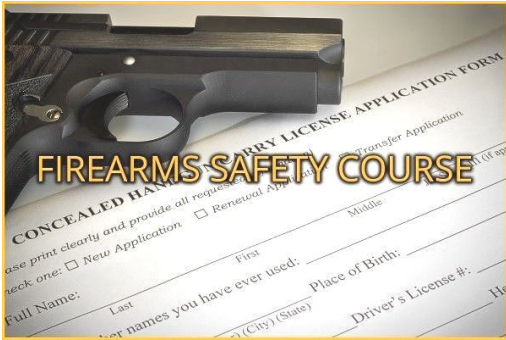
UPCOMING EVENTS

- June 1, 2109 at 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM

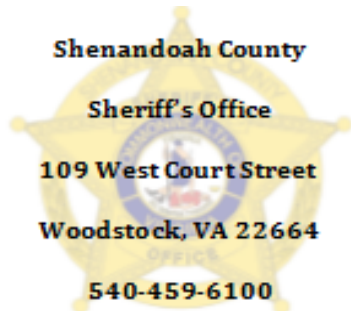
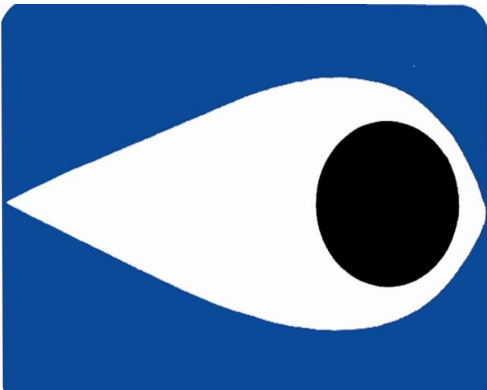


2019 TRIAD Conference
