




- Implemented 2 of the 4 Community Service Deputy Positions, who have also been trained in Drug Court.

Training

DCJS In-Service & Instructorship Training Requirements

DCJS requires that certified staff must complete 4hrs of Legal, 34hrs of Continuing Education, 2hrs of Cultural Diversity training every 2yrs to maintain your certification.

Instructors must teach 8hrs at the academy and complete an online recertification class every 3yrs to maintain active status.

School Resource Officers



School Resource Officers (SRO) are an integral part of the day-to-day operations of the school. Some of the more frequent complaints are assault and battery, larceny of property, weapons violations, & drug, alcohol, and tobacco violations. We have 10 SRO's, 1 in each public school.

D.A.R.E. We currently have a total of 5 certified DARE instructors. DARE was taught at 2 campuses & 350 students graduated from the program in 2022.

SROs handed out over 1,800 backpacks and school supplies to students throughout the county during Stuff The Bus- Back to School Supply Drive. They also provided school supplies to Valley Baptist Christian School, RESPONSE, SCPS, and the Helping Hands Organization.



In 2022, the Shenandoah County Sheriff's Office was able to hold the Annual Kids Camp at Shrinemont where 30+ kids attended the overnight camp.

Crime Prevention



The Sheriff's Office has a total of 5 RAD Instructors. RAD is taught in Shenandoah County Public Schools as well as community groups



There are currently 11 active Neighborhood Watch Groups who meet 9 months out of the year and 2 groups who meet annually. Neighborhood Watch has been back to meeting in person since March of 2022.



TRIAD is a program that educates seniors on topics of interest to them and their quality of life. The TRIAD conference was held at the Woodstock Moose this year with about 75 attendees. We also had a TRIAD event at the Shenandoah County Fair Grounds in 2022.



Crime Prevention



Project Lifesaver is a proven way to reduce search time and loss of life for people that are of risk of becoming lost. Currently we have 10 clients and service all the county. This program serves not only seniors but also children with special needs who are prone to wander

Animal Control

- Animal control responded to a total of 2,022 calls this past year
- 42 dog bites


